01/06/22: JERSEY MTRs

On 01/06/22 the regulated Mobile Termination Rate ('MTR') on Airtel's Jersey network will reduce from 1.1ppm to 0.7ppm. The MTR applies to all call termination services provided by Jersey Airtel Limited in respect of voice calls which originate on a public electronic communications network (whether fixed or mobile) and which are terminated to a mobile number within a number range allocated to Jersey Airtel Limited for which Jersey Airtel Limited is able to set the call termination charge, as defined in the JCRA's Decision on Mobile Pricing published on 17 February 2020 with document number 20/04.
